1. Welcome and introductions
2. Pour the first cup
3. קִידּוּשׁ Kiddush (2)
4. וּרְחַץ Urchatz -- first washing of hands
5. כַּרְפָּס Karpas
6. יָחַץ Yachatz -- show and break the middle matza and hide the afikoman
7. מַגִּיד Maggid Begin with הָא לַחֲמַא עֲנִיאָה Ha Lachma Anya -- This is the bread of poverty (3)
8. Pour second cup and sing the Four Questions (4)
9. עֲבָדִים הָיִינוּ Avadim Hayinu (5)
10. Four Children discussion
11. “From the beginning our ancestors served idols”
12. וְהִיא שְׁעָמְדָה V’hi She-amda (6)
13. Telling and discussing the story
14. The plagues
15. דַּיָּינוּ Dayenu (short or full version -- 7 or 8)
16. Rabban Gamliel says -- the three symbols of the Seder (9)
17. *In every generation, a person is obligated to see himself/herself as having personally gone out from Egypt.*
18. (Not essential but great: בְּצֵאת יִשְׂרָאֵל B’tzeit Yisrael song -- 10)
19. Second cup
20. רְחִיצָה Rochtza -- washing hands with a bracha
21. מוֹצֵיא מַצָּה Motzi-Matza -- eat matza
22. מָרֹר Maror -- eat bitter herbs
23. כּוֹרֵךְ Korech -- “Hillel Sandwich” with matza, maror, charoset
24. שׁוּלְחַן עוֹרֵךְ Shulchan Orech -- Eat!
25. צַפּוּן Tzafun -- find the afikomen and eat it
26. Pour third cup, then בִּרְכָה Barech -- Birkat Hamazon (11) and drink third cup
27. Pour fourth cup and do Eliyahu’s Cup
28. הַלֵּל Hallel -- choose a song or two (12)
29. Songs from the end: choose the ones you like (13-14)
30. Fourth and final cup
31. נִרְצָה Nirtzah -- the end, “Next year in Jerusalem!”
